She holds a Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) and Master of Laws (LL.M.). She was admitted as an Advocate and Solicitor of the Supreme Court of Singapore in August 2020, and is a member of the Law Society of Singapore and the Singapore Academy of Law.

Annette has acted for clients in the following reported Court decisions:

- Successfully acted for big 4 accounting firm, KPMG Services Pte. Ltd. in the High Court in relation to a breach of contract in the case of KPMG Services. Pte. Ltd. v. Pawley, Mark Edward [2021] SGHC 54.

Prior to being admitted as an Advocate and Solicitor of the Supreme Court of Singapore, Annette held a permanent position at the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) for 2 years. She was a researcher to the United Nations Special Rapporteur on the Human Rights of Internally Displaced Persons where she conducted research and drafted thematic reports which was presented to the United Nations Human Rights Council and United Nations General Assembly.
